INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS			
<p>Each year, LSE offers a number of scholarships to exceptional graduates of its Global Programmes (University of London EMFSS) who wish to pursue Master's studies at the School. To be eligible for an LSE Master's Scholarship Award, you must have received an offer for a Master's programme at LSE and have completed a Global Programmes degree within two years of the Master's start date. All scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit.</p>			
<p><b>LSE-UoL Graduate Scholarships</b> Each year, LSE awards <b>two to three partial tuition fee scholarships</b>, each worth up to £15,000, to outstanding Global Programmes graduates admitted to an LSE Master's programme. There are a limited number of scholarships available, typically awarded to students who graduated with first-class honours.</p>			
<p><b>David Webb Scholarship (New from 2026)</b> This separate prestigious award provides <b>up to £30,000 towards tuition fees</b> for an LSE Master's degree and is awarded to one outstanding Global Programmes graduate admitted to the LSE Master's programme.</p>
