The University of London and SIM have over 40 years of successful collaboration. From an initial intake of only 40 students in 1986, there are close to 4,500 current students and over 46,000 graduates who have studied for University of London programmes at SIM.

About the University of London

The University of London is one of the oldest and most prestigious universities in the UK, internationally recognised for its high academic standards. Founded in 1836, the University of London is a federation of 17 self-governing institutions, including the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE), UCL and Goldsmiths, University of London. These federation members are responsible for the academic direction and assessment of all programmes offered worldwide by the University of London.

University of London degrees have been available to study worldwide since 1858. Past students include leaders of business and industry, judges, authors, politicians, and six Nobel Prize winners, including Nelson Mandela. There are now around 40,000 students in 190 countries studying for University of London awards.

In 2017, the University of London–SIM Regional Centre was launched to develop University of London provision in Singapore and the region.

About SIM

SIM is a leading private educational institution in Singapore, known for its high standards and vibrant student experience. It is part of the SIM Group which was set up in 1964 on the initiation of the Singapore Economic Development Board and has 60 years' experience in developing manpower to support Singapore's economic growth. Its state-of-the-art campus has a global atmosphere, with local students mixing with students of other cultures and backgrounds. Students can join extra-curricular

programmes in sports, social and cultural activities. Today, SIM's enrolment stands at about 16,000, which includes both full-time and part-time students in over 140 academic programmes from various international universities.

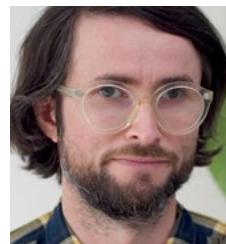

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International Foundation Programme (IFP)

Developed and awarded by University of London, UK.

The IFP is equivalent in standard to A-Levels, and has been designed to prepare students for undergraduate study. Successful completion gives guaranteed entry to all University of London undergraduate degrees offered at SIM, and also meets the entry criteria for many other universities.

The IFP presents a wonderful opportunity for students to progress on to excellent undergraduate programmes and follow in the footsteps of seniors who are now pursuing their degrees at King's College London, University of Bristol, Durham University, University of Leeds and University of Birmingham in the UK.

Students apply directly to SIM to study the International Foundation Programme. Once offered a place, the University of London online application is to be completed.

*Admission to overseas universities is not guaranteed and assessed on a case-by-case basis.

UCL has built an outstanding reputation for the quality of its teaching and research. It is currently ranked 9th in the world by QS World University Rankings 2025 and boasts 32 Nobel Prize winners from across the globe.

Master of Science in Professional Accountancy

This master's degree programme is designed for members of professional accountancy bodies such as ACCA, CPA and CIMA. You can earn a prestigious master's degree by taking just 60 credits – a fast and cost-effective way to stand out from the crowd. Combine the best of both worlds – the technical know-how gained from the professional examinations with the in-depth academic rigour of the UCL School of Management.

An enriching study experience

By enrolling at SIM, you not only benefit from a challenging academic degree – you also have the opportunity to enjoy SIM's vibrant campus life.

Support for your study

All University of London students are provided with resources developed by the University. These include specially written subject guides, an Online Library, and a Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) with online resources and discussion forums where you can meet students from around the world.

Your learning experience at SIM can include a mixture of lectures, breakout lab sessions, workshops, industry talks and excursions. For the LSE-led programmes, SIM organises an intensive revision programme before the annual exams each year, with sessions taught by both UK and local lecturers.



Learn for life, thrive for life

Faculty and staff from LSE, Goldsmiths and UCL are at SIM several times a year to give public lectures and encourage students in their learning. In April 2025, Professor Matthew Yee-King of Goldsmiths, University of London, delivered a keynote lecture to students on computer science and how self-directed projects can help them to learn and grow.

Attending the LSE Summer School

The LSE Summer School is the largest of its kind in Europe and with over 115 courses on offer, it attracts students from over 113 nationalities. The courses are taught by the LSE's top flight academic staff in the heart of London. Each year, LSE offers five or more scholarships for SIM students to attend the LSE Summer School in London. EMFSS students not in receipt of a scholarship will be eligible for up to 40 per cent discount on tuition fees.

Credit transfer for named and unnamed courses is also permitted. Two three-week summer school courses earn 30 credits or no more than one out of 12 full courses in the EMFSS.

Attend the LSE General Course

Students with above average results may apply to study the final year on campus at the LSE as an 'exchange' student under the LSE General Course. In September 2025, three SIM students enrolled for the LSE General Course. They still earn UOL degrees as their LSE course credits will transfer to the UOL programme.

Transferring to a UK university

If you have performed well during the first year of your University of London degree at SIM, you may apply to transfer to the second year of a similar degree as an on-campus student at a UK university. Goldsmiths welcomes transfers from Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Computer Science programmes. For more information, visit: gold.ac.uk/transfer

Vibrant campus life

Students at SIM can enjoy a beautiful campus with lectures halls, an extensive library, and cafes. Outside of class, you can choose from over 70 clubs, from sports to culture, as well as associations devoted to professional and

personal development. SIM offers career development activities and encourages students to take on internships or summer abroad programmes. You can also benefit from the Peer-Assisted Learning (PAL) programme, where senior students support you to help you succeed.

SIM Bursary

The SIM Bursary aims to provide financial assistance to students in need at SIM. This award is given based on eligibility criteria, as well as the assessed level of the need of the applicants. Application opens throughout the year and will be awarded on a quarterly basis.

SIM Scholarships

The SIM Scholarships are awarded to outstanding local and international students to pursue undergraduate degrees at SIM. The bond-free scholarships are awarded each year to new and existing students in the categories of Academic Excellence and Leadership, and Sports and Artistic Talent.

If you do not meet the entry requirements, you may still be eligible for two other programmes:

- The International Foundation Programme is a pre-university programme equivalent to A-Levels. Completing this successfully guarantees your entry to all University of London degrees offered at SIM (unless it requires higher-level maths).
- The Certificate of Higher Education in Social Sciences is a one-year programme which enables students to develop skills and competence to undertake a further two years of LSE-led undergraduate study from University of London at SIM.

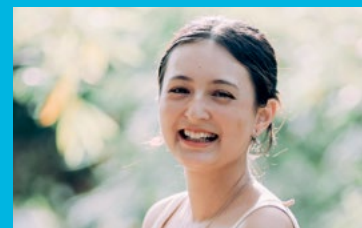

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

RPL may be awarded if you have previously studied a similar subject in the same depth at degree level, and you achieved good marks in the corresponding examinations. A student who is awarded RPL for 120 credits may be able to complete a degree in only two years.

Postgraduate opportunities at top universities

University of London degrees create great opportunities for postgraduate studies.

In 2025–2026 and 2024–2025, University of London graduates from SIM pursued further studies at top UK universities including Cambridge, LSE, UCL, Birmingham, and many more. Many also continued their postgraduate journey at SMU, NUS, and NTU in Singapore.

Master’s scholarship to University of London

Under the auspices of the University of London–SIM Regional Centre, graduates and students in their final year of study can apply for scholarships to pursue master’s at any of the 17 federation members in London. The 2025 scholar Yang Bo has enrolled for a master’s at UCL.



Master's scholarships at LSE

Scholarships are awarded to University of London students who have completed a bachelor's degree with academic direction by LSE and received an LSE offer for postgraduate study.

To date, over 20 SIM students have benefitted. The latest recipient, Lee Yi, is now pursuing Master of Science in Finance.

Fast track to professional accreditation

Graduates of our Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Accounting and Finance and Bachelor of Science

(Honours) in Finance who wish to gain awards from professional bodies may be exempt from certain modules. If you pass the required combination of courses on your degree, you can gain professional accreditation more quickly.

Graduating from the University of London

Your journey with the University of London does not end when you graduate.

The award you receive

When you graduate, you are awarded a University of London degree, diploma or certificate. The final parchment includes the University of London logo and signature of the Vice-Chancellor, and indicates which University of London federation member conducted your examinations. It does not mention that you studied internationally.

Standards you can rely on

The standard of assessment is consistent whether you study on campus in London or elsewhere in the world. This helps to ensure that your University of London qualification is of the same high academic standard, however it is achieved.

Graduation ceremonies in Singapore and London

Graduates can either choose to attend their graduation in London or Singapore. The graduation ceremony in London is presided over by the University of London's Chancellor, HRH the Princess Royal, or the Vice-Chancellor. The graduation ceremony in Singapore is presided over by the Vice-Chancellor and attended by other University of London academic staff.

Access to two Alumni Associations

Upon graduation you automatically become a member of both the SIM and University of London Alumni Associations. The University of London global alumni community spans more than 190 countries, providing graduates with unique networking opportunities. There is a dedicated Alumni Chapter in Singapore, which hosts regular local events.



Private Education Act

The Private Education Act was legislated in December 2009 to regulate the private education institutions (PEIs) in Singapore. The regulatory regime, as set-out under the Private Education Act and its subsidiary legislation, comprises the Enhanced Registration Framework and the EduTrust Certification Scheme, both administered by SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG).

Singapore Institute of Management Pte Ltd (SIM PL), in meeting the regulatory requirements under the Private Education Act, has put in place the following:

- Adoption of the standard PEI-Student Contract template from SSG
- Allowing students a cooling-off period of 10 calendar days commencing from and including the acceptance date of the PEI-Student Contract
- Protection of students' fees under the Fee Protection Scheme
- Transparent refund, course transfer, leave of absence and withdrawal policies
- Commitment in maintaining the confidentiality of students' data.
