BIOGRAPHY OF PROFESSOR JORG BLEY

Professor Jorg Bley is an internationally recognised finance scholar and higher education leader with more than two decades of academic and executive experience. A German native educated in Germany and the United States, he has held senior academic positions in the UAE, China, and beyond.

Since 2019, Professor Bley has served as Dean of the International Business School Suzhou (IBSS) at Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University, the largest Sino-foreign academic joint venture in China. Under his leadership, IBSS achieved the prestigious "triple crown" accreditation from AACSB, EQUIS, and AMBA/BGA, making it the youngest institution worldwide to earn this recognition. During his tenure, student enrolment and faculty numbers doubled, while the school was also named a PRME Champion and recognised by the United Nations Global Compact for its pioneering work in sustainability and social responsibility.

Professor Bley's research focuses on stock market behaviour, valuation anomalies, and market efficiency, with his work widely published in international journals. He has co-authored several influential corporate finance textbooks with a Middle Eastern perspective that are widely used across the MENA region. In addition to his academic career, he brings substantial investment banking expertise and holds leading professional designations including CFA, CAIA, and FRM.

Previously, he served as Dean of the School of Business Administration at the American University of Sharjah and has worked extensively with international accreditation bodies (AACSB, EQUIS, and AMBA) as well as government higher education agencies in the UAE, the US, and China.

Professor Bley is also an experienced international speaker and panellist on topics ranging from leadership, employability, and entrepreneurship.
