

Dear Students,

It has come to our attention that a scam email is currently being circulated among SIM students. This fraudulent message claims that your tuition fees have not been paid on time and provides a bank account number for payment.

Please be informed that **this email is not from SIM**, and the **account number stated does not belong to SIM**.

We would like to remind all students:

- **Do not** make any payments to bank accounts that are not officially listed on SIM's website or student portal.
- **Do not** reply to or click on any links in suspicious emails.
- **Do not** share your personal or financial details with unverified senders.

All official payment instructions and reminders from SIM are sent **only through official SIM email channels** (e.g., *@sim.edu.sg or *@notice.sim.edu.sg) and can be verified via the **SIMConnect portal**.

If you have received such an email or have already made payment to the fraudulent account, please:

1. **Do not engage further with the sender**, and
2. **Report the incident immediately** to SIM Student Services, and at <https://www.scamshield.gov.sg/i-ve-been-scammed/>, and
3. **Inform your bank** as soon as possible.

SIM takes this matter seriously and is working to safeguard our student community. Please remain vigilant and help spread the word to your peers.
