This Selection Kit requires you to complete the following components: two design statements and a selection task consisting of a written statement and a mini-portfolio of 2 or 3 project examples.

- 1. Design statement 1:
 - a) Describe your skills and experience such as employment, voluntary work, etc., and how these will make a contribution to the RMIT – SIM communication design community.
 - b) Describe what you hope to achieve through your studies.(Maximum 200 words)

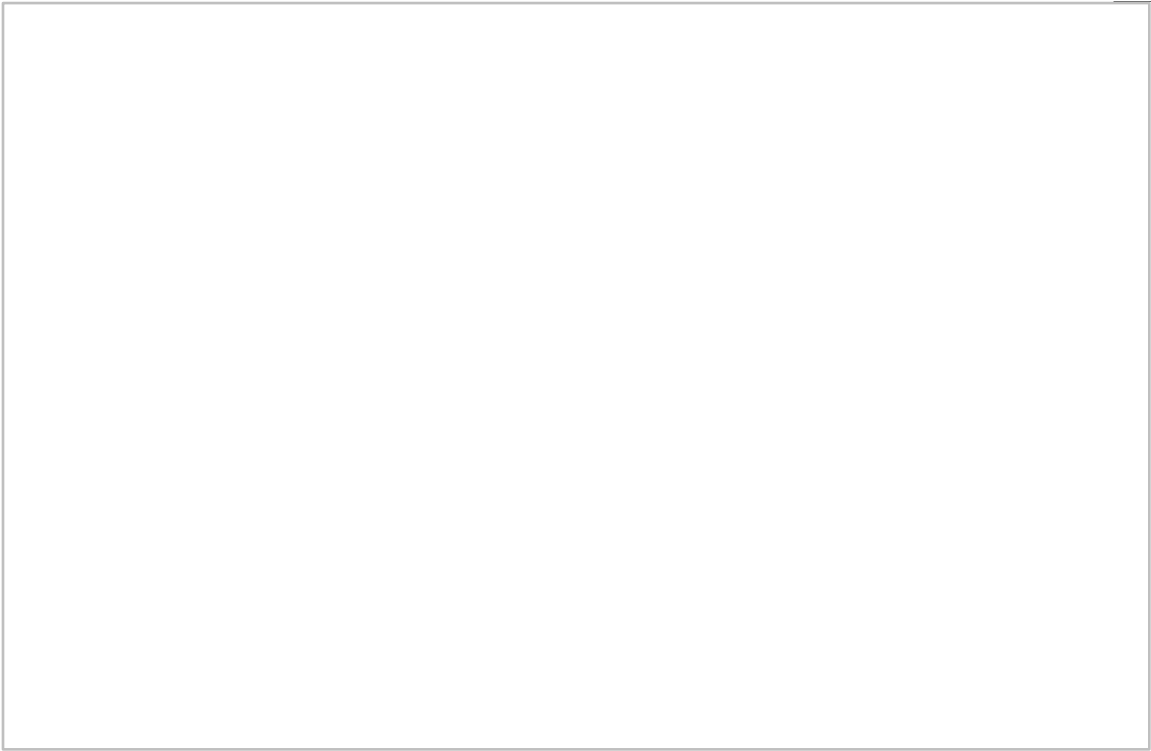

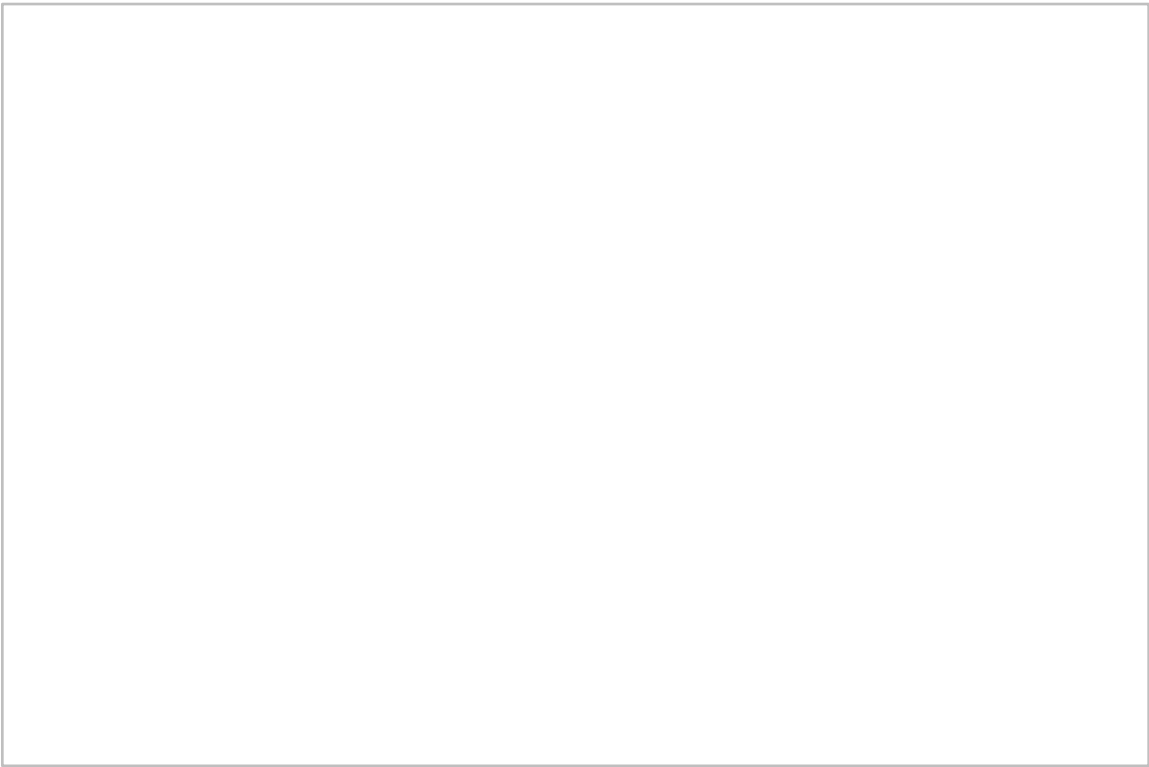

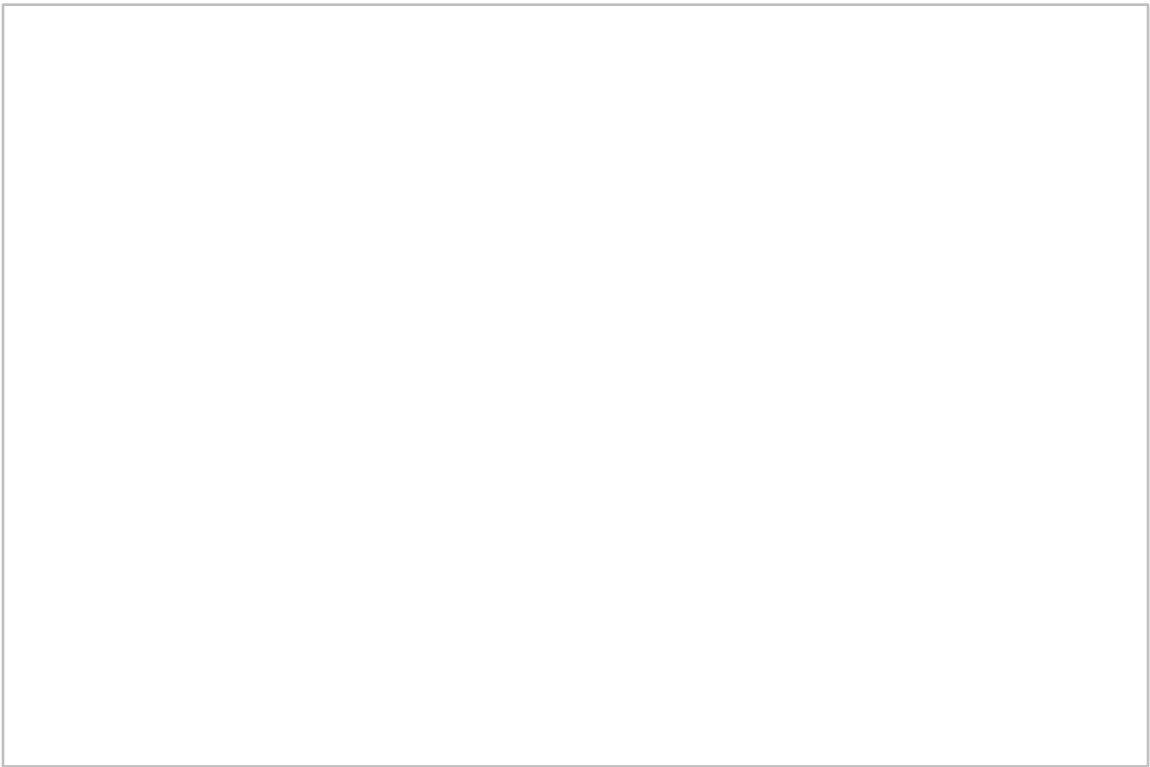
