<b>Int'l Baccalaureate (IB)</b>	Min score 25, min of 4 in English A1 or A2 would satisfy the English requirements
<b>Cambodia</b>	Diploma of Upper Secondary School, plus completion of first year at a recognised university. Assessed on a case-by-case basis. Requires a minimum of C grade average in first year of university for consideration.
<b>China</b>	Senior High School Leaving Certificate (Gao San Certificate): 75% overall average score for all subjects undertaken
<b>Hong Kong</b>	Minimum 15 points from best 5 subjects, including 3 cores subjects Minimum level 2 required for each subject
<b>India</b>	All India ISC - 65% overall average for graded academic subjects HSC - 70% overall average for graded academic subjects
<b>Indonesia</b>	Completed Senior High School Year 12 and passed National Examination (SHUN) with overall score of 80%
<b>Japan</b>	Upper Secondary School Certificate of Graduation (Kotogakko Sotsugyo Shosho) - Passed at GPA 3.0
<b>Kazakhstan</b>	SIM Diplomas (DMS/DAC/DBF/DIB) for direct entry to Year 2. For those taking the Economic and Finance program, the estimated completion of the programme is 2 years (full time).
<b>Laos</b>	Baccalaureate (Upper Secondary School Diploma), plus completion of first year of a Bachelor degree at a recognised university (with at least a C+ / GPA 2.5)

<b>Taiwan</b>	Senior High School Leaving Certificate with overall average of 80% for all subjects examined. Pass grade of 60%
<b>Thailand</b>	Mathayom Suksa 6 / M6 - Year 12 with a CGPA of 3.0 based on a 4 point GPA scale
<b>United Arab Emirates</b>	Tawjihiya (General Secondary Education Certificate Examination) + Completion of first year of a Bachelor degree at a recognised university (with a minimum pass mark average in degree).
<b>United States of America</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- High School Diploma with SAT – GPA 2.5 and a minimum SAT score of 1500 (out of 2400) or 1060 (out of 1600)</li> <li>- High School Diploma with ACT – GPA 2.5 and a minimum ACT composite score of 21</li> </ul>
